



Be aware of caller ID spoofing

Spoofing is when a caller deliberately falsifies the information transmitted to your caller ID display to disguise their identity. Spoofing is often used as part of an attempt to trick someone into giving away valuable personal information so it can be used in fraudulent activity or sold illegally.

- Never give out personal information such as account numbers, Social Security numbers, mother's maiden names, passwords or other identifying information in response to unexpected calls or if you are at all suspicious.
- If you get an inquiry from someone who says they represent a company or a government agency, hang up and call the phone number on your account statement or on the company's or government agency's website to verify the authenticity of the request.
- Don't answer calls from unknown numbers.
- If you answer the phone and the caller or a recording asks you to hit a button to stop getting the calls, you should just hang up.
- Do not respond to any questions, especially those that can be answered with "yes" or "no".
