Credit card controls are here

The new MyCardRules mobile app allows users to manage their CECU credit card by setting controls, restrictions and alerts.

- Turn cards on or off with the app.
- Set limits based on transaction type, merchant type and dollar amount.
- Set specific transaction types to allow or refuse, such as in-store, online and at ATMs.
- Set specific merchant types to allow or refuse, such as department stores, gas stations and grocery stores.
- Set location preferences by location, region or country.
- Receive instant alerts on certain types of transactions, such as when a transaction is declined.
- Set parental controls and monitoring.

Reminder: Since we upgraded our credit card program in April 2024, cash-back rewards are no longer paid automatically. Now, you can redeem your points through online banking or by calling 855-854-5493. Points don't expire for two years from the date of purchase, so you can build them up for a larger cash-back amount, merchandise, travel or gift cards!

Do your 2025 plans include international travel? Be sure to pack your CECU debit card, and rest easy, knowing we don't charge any fees for using it outside the United States – even at ATMs. Happy booking!

Think before you scan Avoid QR code scams

While most QR codes are harmless and can be helpful, some scammers use them to get your personal information. Protect yourself from harmful QR codes by following these tips:

- If you see a QR code in an unexpected place, inspect
 the URL before you open it. QR codes found at gas
 station pumps or in other public places may be covered
 by a scammer's code. Always check the URL to confirm its
 legitimacy. If it looks like a URL you recognize, make sure
 you look for misspellings or a switched letter.
- Don't scan a QR code in an email or text message you weren't expecting. If the message says you must act immediately, it's probably fraudulent. If you think the message is legitimate, use a legitimate phone number or website you know of to contact the company.
- Protect your phone and accounts. Update your phone's operating system to protect against hackers and protect your online accounts with strong passwords and multifactor authentication.





The Missouri Conservation Heritage Foundation (MCHF) invites you to connect with nature and experience its transformative benefits. From backyard moments to all-day hikes, nature offers peace, companionship and fresh air.

Since its founding 27 years ago, MCHF has supported conservation efforts across Missouri. Highlights from 2024 include:

- Investing in the Next-Generation Conservation Professionals:
 MCHF partners with the Johnny Morris Institute, which trains students
 in fisheries, wetlands and aquatic systems, and is supported by the
 McGeehan Careers Pathway Program.
- Connecting ecosystems with OneHealth Initiative: Linking human, animal and ecosystem health, this program promotes preventive care with nature-based prescriptions and local food initiatives.
- Archery programs: MCHF hosts archery tournaments, fostering community and mentorship while engaging with more than 5,100 participants annually.
- **Habitat protection:** MCHF holds 1,322 acres in conservation easements, with more planned.
