The CECU bylaws state that any other candidate wishing to place his or her name on the ballot for an open position may do so by collecting the signatures of 26 members who are eligible to vote. This petition must be returned to the board chairman, David Urich. The closing date for receiving nominations by petition is Jan. 29, 2018.

We will hold an online volunteer election to fill vacant board of directors and supervisory committee positions prior to the annual meeting. Voting and annual meeting reservations will open on Monday, March 12, and close Friday, April 13. Be sure to visit our website to save your place at the table and cast your vote. If you are not able to vote online, you may contact the credit union during normal business hours to request that a paper ballot be sent to you.

In contrast to us, monarch butterflies have completed their flight south and are now basking in the warmth of sunny Mexico – thanks in part to the second National Fish and Wildlife (NFWF) grant awarded to the Missouri Conservation Heritage Foundation (MCHF). Fuel for monarch migration comes in the form of nectar from acres of milkweed plants established MISSOURI conservation HERITAGE FOUNDATION

with the help of multiple partners. With matching funds, and our NFWF grant awarded in 2016, more than \$1.3 million is now building monarch habitats in the Show-Me State.

Flight plans are also in place for the National Archery in Schools Program Missouri State Championship – landing in Branson on March 23-24, 2018. Imagine more than 2,500 students taking aim and letting those arrows fly both in bullseye and 3-D competitions at the Branson Convention Center.
